According to the Ohio Department of Health (ODH), schools that do not provide the services of a nurse and/or health professional to their students must provide the following information to families in order to get their son or daughter screened for Developmental Disorders. Developmental disabilities are a group of conditions due to impairment in physical, learning, language, or behavior areas. These conditions begin during the developmental period, may impact day-to-day functioning, and usually last throughout a person's lifetime.
